

PREVENTIVE CARE UPDATES FOR 2019

| Screening/Service |
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| USPSTF (A or B Rating) |
| Folic acid supplements for women planning or capable of pregnancy |
| Pre-eclampsia screening |
| Obesity screening in children and adolescents age 6 and older |
| Vision screening at least once in all children ages 3 to 5 to detect amblyopia or its risks |
| Skin cancer behavioral counseling for people age 6 months to 24 years with fair skin |
| Fall prevention exercise interventions |
| Osteoporosis screening for women 65 or older, and for postmenopausal women under age 65 at increased risk |
| Cervical cancer screening, starting at age 21 |
| Obesity screening and counseling for adults with BMI of 30 or higher |
| Syphilis screening for pregnant women |
| Intimate partner violence screening for women of reproductive age |
| Unhealthy alcohol use screening and counseling for adults age 18 and older |
| Bright Futures Recommendation |
| Hearing screenings at birth, between 3-5 days and 2 months old, and at 4, 6, and 9 months of age |
| Depression screening for adolescents starting at age 12 |
| Screening for maternal depression at 1-, 2-, 4- and 6-month visits |
| Screening for bilirubin at newborn visit |
| Screening for dyslipidemia once between ages 9 and 11 and once between ages 17 and 21 |
| HIV screening for adolescents once between ages 15 and 18 |
| Oral health assessments at 12-month and at 18-month through six-year visits |
| Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices |
| Updated recommendations for DTaP, Tdap and Td vaccinations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5 dose series, at 2, 4, 6 and 15-18 months and 4-6 years (DTaP) • 1 dose between ages 11-18 (Tdap) • Booster every 10 years (Td) • Vaccination with every pregnancy (Tdap) |
| Updated Hepatitis B vaccination recommendations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All infants within 24 hours of birth (12 hours, if mother has Hep B) • Children and adolescents age 19 or younger who have not been previously vaccinated • At risk adults, and adults who request it |
